<input type="checkbox"/>	CLOSE CAR WINDOWS, CHECK GAS, FACE CAR OUT, HOOK HOUSE & CAR KEYS TO BELT LOOP
<input type="checkbox"/>	PUT GO BAGS & COMPUTER HARD DRIVE IN CAR
<input type="checkbox"/>	CONTACT FAMILY AND FOLLOW PREPARATION PLAN
<input type="checkbox"/>	LOCATE PETS AND PUT INTO A SAFE AREA (SMOKE MIGHT MAKE THEM HIDE)
<input type="checkbox"/>	PREPARE FARM ANIMALS FOR TRANSPORT – HOOK UP TRAILER
<input type="checkbox"/>	CLOSE ALL DOORS, WINDOWS, FIRE PLACE FLUE, SWAMP COOLER AND AIR CONDITIONER
<input type="checkbox"/>	COVER SLIDING DOORS AND WINDOWS WITH REFLECTIVE FIRE RESISTANT COVERING, MOVE FURNITURE AWAY FROM WINDOWS
<input type="checkbox"/>	REMOVE DECK FURNITURE, FLAMMABLE DECORATIONS AND BBQ PROPANE TANKS AWAY FROM THE HOUSE; TURN OFF PROPANE/NG VALVES
<input type="checkbox"/>	HAVE HOSES AND SPRINKLERS READY, FILL BUCKETS, PLACE LADDER OUTSIDE AND VISIBLE TO FIREFIGHTERS
<input type="checkbox"/>	WET DOWN HOUSE , ROOF AND YARD IF THERE IS A GOOD SUPPLY OF WATER



EVACUATION CALLED-REGISTER WITH RED CROSS

<input type="checkbox"/>	OFFICIAL EVACUATION IS CALLED <u>ONLY</u> BY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT
<input type="checkbox"/>	GET YOUR ANIMALS INTO THE CAR/CRATES
<input type="checkbox"/>	FOLLOW SHERIFF'S INSTRUCTIONS UNTIL YOU GET TO THE RED CROSS SHELTER
<input type="checkbox"/>	DO NOT ASK DEPUTIES QUESTIONS WHILE ON EVACUATION ROUTE
<input type="checkbox"/>	QUESTIONS WILL BE ANSWERED ONCE YOU ARE AT THE SHELTER
<input type="checkbox"/>	EXPECT HEAVY SMOKE
<input type="checkbox"/>	SHERIFF AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT WILL HAVE SPECIALLY EQUIPPED AMBULANCES ON STANDBY FOR SPECIAL NEEDS RESIDENTS (IF NEEDED)

<input type="checkbox"/>	STAY CALM, DRIVE SLOWLY AND CAREFULLY – OBEY SPEED LIMITS
<input type="checkbox"/>	CLOSE VEHICLE VENTS AND WINDOWS
<input type="checkbox"/>	FOLLOW SHERIFF'S DIRECTION TO RED CROSS SHELTER
<input type="checkbox"/>	AT SHELTER – INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE GIVEN CONCERNING SHELTERING PETS
<input type="checkbox"/>	CHECK IN WITH RED CROSS, THEN YOU CAN GO WHERE YOU WANT TO

HELPFUL HINTS



<input type="checkbox"/>	PHONES/CELL MIGHT BE DOWN - TEXTING MIGHT WORK
<input type="checkbox"/>	ELECTRICITY MIGHT BE DOWN – PUMPS TO WATER MIGHT NOT WORK
<input type="checkbox"/>	CALLING OUT OF STATE MIGHT WORK – HAVE A CONTACT THERE
<input type="checkbox"/>	EACH FAMILY MEMBER SHOULD HAVE A PLAN AND PHONE LIST W/ THEM
<input type="checkbox"/>	ROADS TO THE EAST MOUNTAIN FROM ALBUQUERQUE WILL PROBABLY BE CLOSED
<input type="checkbox"/>	EAST MT SCHOOLS HAVE A PLAN FOR EVACUATION – MAKE SURE YOUR KIDS UNDERSTAND THE PLAN
