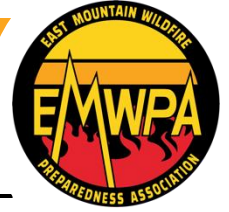

### What are your home's top 3 accessibility hazards and concerns?

- Address hidden or not easily visible to first responders
- Driveway width less than 12 feet
- Locked gate
- Road grade greater than 10%

### What vegetation conditions surround your home?

- Densely packed trees within 30 feet of structure
- Bushes and shrubs within 30 feet of structure
- Trees with limbs touching the ground
- Ground fuels—ornamentals, shrubs, leaves—touching or within 3 feet of a structure

### Steep slopes are a potential fire hazard. Does your property have?

- Steep slope—grade greater than 10%
- Gradual slope—grade less than 10%

### Combustible materials are a fire hazard. Does your property have:

- Sand, gravel or other noncombustible materials
- Other driveway material

### What type of roof material do you have?

- Metal
- Tile
- Tar/gravel
- Shingles

### What fire hazards are near your roof?

- Tree limbs overhanging the roof
- Gutters, corners, and crevices filled with leaf litter
- Vents and eaves open and unscreened

### Are your exterior walls flame-resistant?

- Noncombustible materials—brick, metal, or adobe
- Combustible materials—log, wood, or plastic
- Double-paned windows with tempered glass rather than single-paned
- Metal window and screen frames rather than plastic

### In your fire hazard assessment, have you considered home attachments—decks, fences, portals?

- Debris, leaf litter, and flammable materials on or near structure
- Flammable outdoor furniture on deck or portal when you're away—or evacuated
- Attachments treated with same material as structure

### Hazard reduction: List one course of action you can take today.

- Regularly clean roof and gutters if you can do so safely.
- Install 3 feet of gravel or nonflammable material around structure.
- Store all wood piles at least 30 feet from structure.
- Mow grass within 30 feet of structure.
- Rake leaf and needle litter within 30 feet of structure.
- Remove ladder fuels within 30 feet of structure.
